There is a culvert across the street and 2 catch basins that feed the culvert on my property. The culvert on my property is in COMPLETE despair. It is my understanding that not only the developers engineering firm but another one hired to be independent have done or in the process of producing drainage reports. How can they accurately calculate waterflow with antiquated infostructure? Just replacing the culvert to todays design specs will concentrate and increase the water flow. My fear is the building will be built and the culvert will be replaced long after. I am also concerned with all the sentiment that flows from the catch basins on RT 140, they may not be able to increase the waterflow (witch I believe there is no way cutting a road in cant) but they can increase the time in witch that water flows....the sediment will build up no matter what is done I will end up with more water flow,more sediment and my property will suffer. I would like the culvert replaced and a pipe put in to handle the excess water. I would like this entered into public record. I am speaking with an engineering firm on my own and considering consulting an attorney. Could you please let me know where I can find the pertinent information regarding the drainage? Also has the culvert and intermittent stream on my property even been included in the studies? Please let me know, thank you for all your help.

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
